

For Kids 4 Years - 6th Grade



Beacon of Hope is hosting a Lunch and Learn with True Charity joining us virtually to learn more about the biblical principles of effective charity. It will be held on Wednesday, June 25th, from 11:30am-1:00pm in the Youth Room. Teen Service (Missions) Trip Boston, MA June 28-July 4



What Will We Be Doing?

From June 28-July 4 First Baptist Church will send a group of 17 to serve alongside Open Air Campaigners (Paintboard Ministry) in Boston, MA. Our trip is going to be facilitated by Brian Harmon. We will be doing a 5-day kids club in a neighborhood 2 blocks from the church (we start the 5-Day Kid's Club on Sunday afternoon). We will do some adult outreaches in downtown Boston. Throughout the week, there will be a few meetings for training and evangelism lectures. Wednesday p.m. we hope to do some evening ministry (blacklight) on the beach/boardwalk. We will be partnering some with members from Lighthouse; this is a great way to build a bridge from the community to the church.

How Can You Pray?

This trip is going to be a Spiritually challenging trip as it is going to require students to be bold in the proclamation of the Gospel. Pray that God would already be working in our hearts of our students, and of the people who will hear the Gospel through our students on the trip.

What is the Cost?

One of the hallmarks of FBC is our generosity. We are committed to supporting our students financially because we value their spiritual growth. <u>The Pastors' Book of the Month</u> <u>Recommendation</u>

Tim Keller on the Christian Life: The Transforming Power of the Gospel by Matt Smethurst (Crossway) Pastor and author Timothy Keller (1950–2023) built a lasting legacy in Christian ministry, planting Redeemer Presbyterian Church and cofounding the Gospel Coalition. With sharp biblical insight that has shaped countless church leaders, along with counsel on the Christian life that has stirred and strengthened audiences worldwide, Keller's teaching promises to influence generations to come.

Synthesizing Keller's work topic by topic, each chapter of this book highlights a key aspect of the Christian life– covering his views on prayer, suffering, friendship, vocation, intimacy with God, and more. Written by pastor Matt Smethurst, *Tim Keller on the Christian Life* draws from Keller's nearly 50 years of sermons, conference messages, and books to share practical theological insight that will galvanize leaders and laypeople alike.

AM Sermon Notes

Message - When You Grow Weary, Consider Jesus Hebrews 12:3-4 Pastor Tim Knaus Communion

- I. The Purpose of the Cross
 - A. At the cross of Calvary, the Lord Jesus Christ completely accomplished our salvation through the shedding of His blood in His sacrificial, substitutionary death.

2 Corinthians 5:21

Romans 10:9

B. Salvation is by grace alone through faith alone in the accomplished work of Jesus on the cross and not as a result of good works.

Ephesians 2:8-9

- II. The Example of the Cross
 - A. God designed the life and death of Jesus to be a powerful example and inspiration for every Christian to live a faithful, God-honoring life.
 - B. Today's passage of Scripture heightens the importance of the Lord's Supper as we not only remember Christ's death and resurrection but are inspired and motivated to live for Him.

Here is how you can accept Christ into your life:

- Admit your need. (*I am a sinner*)
- Be willing to turn from your sins. (Repent)
- Believe that Jesus Christ died for you on the cross and rose from the grave. (*Be saved by faith*)
- Through prayer, invite Jesus Christ to control your life through the Holy Spirit. (*Receive him as Lord and Savior*)

We suggest a prayer like this one:

"Dear God, I know I'm a sinner, and I ask for your forgiveness. I believe Jesus Christ is Your Son. I believe that He died for my sin and that you raised Him to life. I want to trust Him as my Savior and follow Him as Lord, from this day forward. Guide my life and help me to do your will. I pray this in the name of Jesus. Amen."
